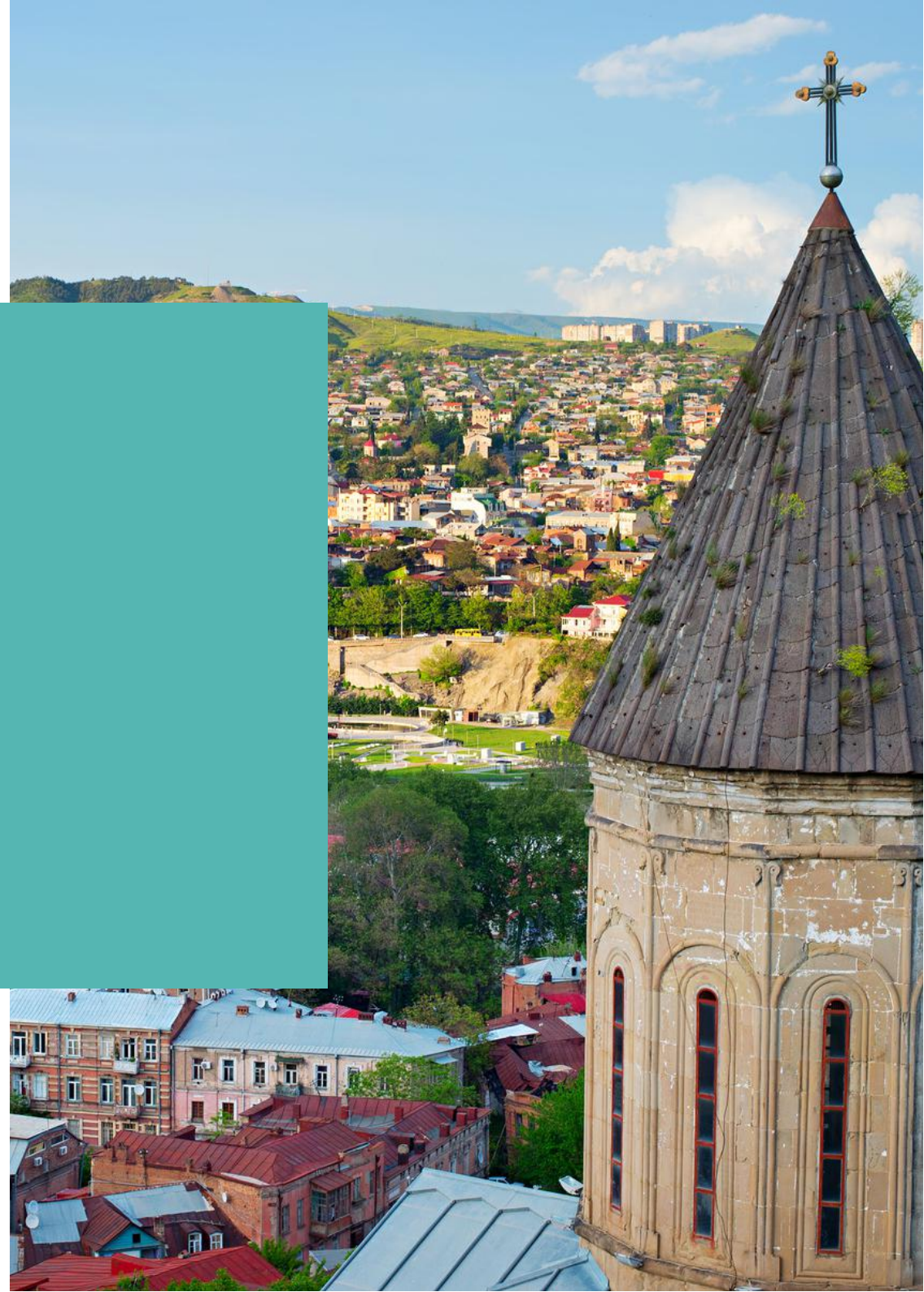

## DAY 1 - ARRIVAL YEREVAN SIGHTSEEING TOUR

- Meet and greet at the airport. Transfer to the hotel. We will have a walk in the pink city of Yerevan. This ancient city is 29 years older than Rome. We will start walking in the most pleasant **Republic Square** with Government buildings, History Museum and Marriott Hotel surrounding it.
- In the evening, we can enjoy the colorful singing and dancing fountains. In case of desire we can visit a jewelry gallery, where we can buy exclusive jewelry. The jewels presented are executed in a single copy and are unique. Walking up one of the oldest streets in Yerevan – Abovyan Street – we will appear in the richest avenue in Yerevan – **the Northern Avenue with many brand shops, luxurious cafes and restaurants. Our next stop – the Opera and Ballet House and the Swan Lake – face the Northern Avenue.**
- We will enjoy our time in the fascinating weather of the sunny Yerevan while walking around **Cascade Monument**. If we walk up the “huge staircase” of 500 meters’ height and 50 meters’ width, we can enjoy the wonderful panorama of the city with the spectacular Opera House, Mount Ararat as well as the view to the whole city. Overnight at the hotel in Yerevan.





## DAY 2 - YEREVAN – GARNI TEMPLE – GEGHARD MONASTERY – LAVASH BAKING MASTERCLASS – YEREVAN

- After breakfast at the hotel, we will then explore the top tourist attractions of Armenia and make the first stop at Garni Temple, where we will enjoy the astonishing view to the gorges all around.
- Garni is a pagan temple built in 1st century, the only survival of the Hellenic epoch in the whole territory of the Caucasus. Upon desire the guide will accompany us to the place called “Symphony of stones” in the gorge.
- We will Continue on to the Monastery of Geghard (UNESCO). The monastery was first recorded in a document of 1250. Geghard is famous due to the relics, among which the most important one is the spear which had wounded Christ on the Cross presumably brought there by the Apostle Thaddeus. Here in Geghard, we can also watch the process of “lavash” baking in the traditional underground oven “tonir”.
- Return to Yerevan.
- Overnight at the hotel in Yerevan.





## DAY 3 - YEREVAN – LAKE SEVAN – DILIJAN – TBILISI

After breakfast at the hotel, we will explore the top tourist attractions of Armenia:

- Lake Sevan where we will have optional lake cruise on the boat and end the lake tour at Sevanavank Monastery on the semi peninsula.
- The trip to Sevan is undoubtedly one of the most exciting ones in Armenia. This wonder of nature is surrounded by Geghama Mountains. The sweet waters, sandy beaches and fresh air attract holiday makers every year. During the 8th century a few monks settled on the former island of Sevan in the present day Sevanavank Monastery, and began to build their churches. Due to the strategically good location, many others came here.
- For a while it was the residence of the king Ashot Erkat (Ashot the Iron) who received his name due to his numerous glorious victories. With the time the walls of the monastery were destroyed and in 1930 the last monk left the monastery. We will then drive to have a walk in the wonderfully forested region of Dilijan to enjoy the 19th century appearance of the town.
- Dilijan is rich in mineral waters. Some of them are compared with Wichi in France and Davos in Switzerland. Moreover, Dilijan is often called “the Switzerland of Armenia.” Our next stop is Haghpat Monastery. One of the most ancient attractions of Lori, Haghpat Monastery was built in the 10th through 13th centuries. Haghpat Monastery was once one of the largest centers of science, with a rich collection of manuscripts.
- Transfer to Tbilisi. Border formalities. Change of transport, guide and driver at the border. Afterwards, we will proceed to Tbilisi by car transfer.
- Overnight in Tbilisi.





## DAY 5 - TBILISI – ANANURI FORTRESS – GUDAURI – KAZBEGI – GERGETI TRINITY CHURCH – TBILISI

- Hiking tour in Kazbegi. Mount Kazbegi is a dormant stratovolcano and one of the major mountains of the Caucasus located on the border of Georgia's Kazbegi District and Russia's Republic of North Ossetia. It is the third-highest peak in Georgia (after Mount Shkhara and Janga) and the seventh-highest summit in the Caucasus Mountains.
- Ananuri castle and church -The fortress is on the UNESCO Tentative list; the fortress overlooks the reservoir and surrounding mountains are spectacular; Ananuri castle represents a multifunctional architectural complex of the late feudal times in Georgia. The castle of Ananuri, the bell tower, two churches, and beautifully carved walls are the highlights of why the site is frequently visited.
- The amazing view from Gudauri Friendship Monument. You can do paragliding there as well.
- Free time at Stepantsminda Town the center of the Kazbegi region for relaxing and lunch at local restaurants.
- The region, with its many valleys and peaks, is one of the most popular walking destinations in Georgia.
- Gergeti Trinity Church and an amazing view of Kazbegi. The church is located on the top of the mountain on the height of 2170 meters from sea level; the place is one of the most popular tourist spots in Georgia because of its stunning view over the mount Kazbegi.

After breakfast at the hotel, spend your day at your leisure. In the late evening, the transfer will take you to the Tbilisi international airport for your flight back home. End of the tour.
