



DAY 1: ARRIVAL TO TBILISI INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT & TRANSFER TO BATUMI

- Check in the hotel in Batumi 15:00 PM
- Free time on own leisure
- Overnight




DAY 2: BATUMI CITY TOUR & BOTANICAL GARDEN

- Breakfast at the hotel
- 10:00 AM excursion to Batumi (duration 3-4 hours)
- During the walking city tour, you will visit some of the most important sights of the old part of Batumi, known for its historic buildings. Going through the charming streets of old city with unique and amazing buildings with old and modern architecture. Batumi walking tour includes visits to: Batumi Boulevard, Statue of Medea, Piazza, Batumi Sea Port, Alphabetic Tower, Monument Ali and Nino
- Batumi Botanical Garden One of the largest and richest botanical gardens in the world, it is situated on 111 hectares and was set up in 1912. The garden includes the Colchis Forest Reserve and many different floristic landscapes. There are many species and varieties of plants in the garden
- There is no similar botanical garden in the world in the sense that the species of plants derived from completely different climatic and landscape zones coexist in Batumi Botanical Garden. In this magical garden, both the palm of the Canary Finch and the Japanese Sakura are equally flourished.
- Transfer back to the hotel

DAY 3: TOUR TO MAKHUNTSETI WATERFALL

- Breakfast at the hotel
- 10:00 AM Transfer to Makhuntseti (40-minute drive)
- Makhuntseti waterfall tour Adjara is an Autonomous Republic in the territory of Georgia located in the utmost southwest of Georgia. All year long it is immersed in green forests and washed by the Black Sea. Mild climate and majestic nature reign there. Sea beaches, mountain ridges, velvet woods, crystal waterfalls, stone gorges, bottomless lakes, foamy rivers and many other beautiful natural attractions are gathered in this small nook of the earth

- Overnight




DAY 5:TBILISI CITY TOUR

- Breakfast at the hotel
- 10:00 AM Proceed old city tour (duration 3-4 hours, mostly walking tour)

During the excursion you will visit:

- Metekhi Church The heroic King Vakhtang Gorgasali commissioned the building of the inscribed-cross church in the 5th century. It is dramatically located on the cliff overlooking the Mtkvari River
- Narikala Fortress an ancient <u>fortress</u> overlooking <u>Tbilisi</u> . Enjoy the panorama of the city
- The Sulfur Old Baths A touch of Old Tbilisi, built in 17th century, have subterranean pavilions topped by unique the red brick domes with steam from the hot springs streaming from their tops, giving a magical atmosphere to this historic area of old homes and interesting shops
- Chardin Street is one of the oldest streets of Tbilisi. Now this is a favorite meeting place for its fancy cafes and clubs, little art salons and galleries. The street got this name in honor of the famous French artist, Jean-Baptiste-Simeon Chardin
- Peace Bridge a bow-shaped <u>pedestrian bridge</u>, a steel and glass construction illuminated with numerous <u>LEDs</u>, over the <u>Mtkvari River</u>, linking the Rike Park with <u>Old town</u> in central <u>Tbilisi</u>
- Continue our way to Mtasminda part were will take a ride with Funicular train
- Transfer back to the hotel in Tbilisi
- Overnight



DAY 6: ANANURI, GUDAURI & KAZBEGI TOUR

- Breakfast at the hotel
- 10:00 AM driver & Guide will meet you & start the tour
- (3-hour drive)

During the tour you will visit:

- Zhinvali Dam is a hydroelectric dam on the Aragvi River in Zhinvali, Georgia in the Caucasus Mountains. Despite its obviously artificial origins, reservoir blends in with the surrounding environment perfectly and delights visitors with its turquoise waters.
- Ananuri is a fortress situated on the foreland by the Aragvi River, not far from Zhinvali water reservoir and about 70 km from Tbilisi, Georgia. It was built by the Dukes of Aragvi and its earliest parts date from the 13th century. The fortress is on the UNESCO Tentative list.
- Gudauri The ski resort is located on the south-facing plateau of The Greater Caucasus Mountain Range in Georgia. The resort is situated in the Stepantsminda District, along the Georgian Military Highway near the Cross Pass, at an elevation of 2,200 meters, above sea level with skiable area enjoying maximum exposure to the sun
- Monument or Treaty (of Georgievsk Monument) is a monument build in 1983 to celebrate the bicentennial of the Treaty of Georgievsk and ongoing friendship between Georgia and Soviet Russia
- Gergeti Trinity Church The old Georgian Church is located under the Mount Kazbek, 2170m above the town of Stepantsminda (former Kazbegi) and village of Gergeti whose name she had adopted. The church is widely known as Gergeti trinity Church thought Georgians call it Gergeti "Tsminda Sameba". It was built in the 14th century, but not much is known to us of its history, though it was mentioned in one of the guide books from 1906, that the church was built on the place that used to be pagan idols worshiping. – (UPON WEATHER CONDINTIONS)
- Transfer guests to Tbilisi hotel
- Overnight
